# CHAPTER 2 ROY MUTTER SOCCER FIELD CONCEPT DESIGN

#### 2.1 Conceptual Design

CBCL developed a conceptual site layout for proposed upgrades to the Roy Mutter Recreational Fields site. The conceptual site layout can be seen on the attached SK1 in Appendix A.

Facility upgrades are proposed to include:

- 1. Field widening
- 2. Access road upgrade
- 3. Parking area upgrade
- 4. Washroom and storage building
- 5. Player seating
- 6. Field re-grading
- 7. Gate and fence upgrades
- 8. Ball fencing/netting
- 9. Field equipment (Lacrosse, Field Hockey and Soccer nets)

Optional upgrades include:

- 10. Field lengthening
- 11. Field and site lighting
